At the request of the Council of Professional Associations of Federal
Statistics (COPAFS) and the approval by the PMRA board, PMRA signed the
COPAFS statement on executive actions related to government data being
removed from federal websites and data portals.

members' ability to conduct public management research at the heart of the
PMRA mission, the board approved this action. The President of PMRA, Rob
Christensen, has appointed the faculty Secretariate, Zach Mohr, to form an
ad hoc committee on policy statements that will review when it is appropriate
for PMRA to sign or issue statements such as this one that are in support of
